**October 25 EDMONTON - CALGARY**  
 Late afternoon Motorcoach to **Calgary's** Delta Airport Hotel.

**October 26 CALGARY - QUITO**  
 0700 departure to Houston, and then on to **Quito**. Transfer from Quito Airport to **Dann Carlton Hotel**.

**October 27 QUITO**  
 The visit will start with early lunch in a local Quito restaurant, then drive just 25 minutes north of Quito to visit "La Mitad del Mundo" (**the Equator**) and take advantage of the opportunity to stand on both hemispheres at the same time. A visit to the Equatorial Museum is included. Continue with the sightseeing excursion back to see the best of **Quito**, which is known as the **Andean Shangri-la**. Visit the **Independence Square, the Archbishop's Palace and the Santo Domingo Church and Convent** which houses the best exhibition of architectural and religious art in the colonial city. Dinner at a local restaurant and then return to hotel. (B/L/D)

**October 28 QUITO – THE NORTHERN HIGHLANDS**  
 Early buffet breakfast before travelling north to the province of Imbabura, a magical land of lakes and a stop at the famous **Otavallo Market** which is famous for its hand made textiles, ponchos, hats, Indian jewellery & handicrafts. After lunch, a visit to **Cotacachi**, an artisans' centre known for its leather. Visit to a Rose Plantation on return to Quito. Visit a Folklore Ballet "Humanizarte" then transfer to local restaurant in Quito for dinner before returning to the hotel. (B/L/D)

**October 29 QUITO - GALAPAGOS**  
 After breakfast, transfer from hotel to airport to take departure flight to The Galapagos Islands. Arrive in **Baltra** and transfer to board **MV GALAPAGOS LEGEND**. (B)

**October 29 – November 2 GALAPAGOS ISLANDS**  
*All meals included from lunch on arrival day to breakfast on departure day. Each day there are 2 daily visits to the islands conducted by naturalist guides.*

**November 3 LIMA**  
 After breakfast, a half day City Tour. Buffet lunch at **Mangos Café Restaurant**. Afternoon Tour of the **Archeological Museum**, with some free time for shopping. Special Dinner at local restaurant before return to hotel. (B/L/D)

**November 4 LIMA – CUSCO**  
 Breakfast and then transfer to the Airport for our flight to **Cusco**. Upon arrival in **Cusco**, it is recommended there be no lunch; only tea served to help acclimatize to altitude change. Half day tour of Cusco and nearby ruins. **Dinner and Folk Show** at local restaurant before returning to **Eco Inn Cusco Hotel** (B/D)

**November 5 MACHU PICCHU**  
 Buffet Breakfast and then transfer to MAPI to board the **Vistadome Train** for full day excursion to **Machu Picchu** and lunch. For return to **Cusco**, board the **Hiram Bingham Luxury Service Train**, enjoying dinner on board the train. (B/L/D)

**November 6 SACRED VALLEY**  
 Buffet Breakfast and then depart for the **Sacred Valley** by air-conditioned motorcoach, and English speaking guide. Full day tour to the **Fortress of Ollantaytambo and Pisac Market**, with lunch enroute, at a local Restaurant. A special gourmet dinner has been arranged at **La Cava de San Rafael Restaurant** before returning to hotel. (B/L/D)

**November 7/8 CUSCO - LIMA - HOME**  
 Late afternoon departure from Cusco to Lima. Dinner in Lima and then an overnight flight to Houston, arriving in **Calgary** around 12:20 pm (Nov. 8). Motorcoach to Edmonton. (B/D)

1. **To secure your reservation:** a Non Refundable Deposit of \$750.00 CAD is required. Final payment is due 70 days prior to departure. Payment can be made by cheque, cash, MasterCard or Visa.
2. **Travel Documents Required:** A valid Canadian Passport - which must be valid for a minimum of 6 months after the tour return date, to Canada.
3. **Health Requirements:** Please contact the **Travel Health Authorities** and show them this Itinerary, so that they may advise you of any recommended vaccinations or medications such as, but not limited to: Yellow Fever (possible Exemption Letter) Hepatitis A; Tetanus; Travellers Diarrhea; High Altitude Sickness.
4. **Baggage & Seat Selection:** **Seats** are allocated by the Airlines, but, we will try our best to accommodate your requests. **Recommended Baggage:** **1** Checked Bag and **1** Carry-on, per person. International Flights do allow 2 Checked Bags, per person, 23 kg per bag, **however**, the problem is with the Domestic Flights within Peru and Ecuador as a total weight of only 20 kg is allowed and a Baggage Surcharges may be collected for any excess.
5. **Tour Prices:** The prices are based on rates in effect at the time of printing. These prices are established in accordance with airfares, exchange rates and various other factors. In the event of an increase, VISION 2000 TRAVEL GROUP reserves the right to increase the cost of the tour, **unless Full Payment** has been received.
6. **Itinerary & Hotels:** Travel arrangements are at the final discretion of the authorities concerned. VISION 2000 TRAVEL GROUP has no control over this portion and cannot be held responsible for changes. On the occasion where a hotel has overbooked its capacity, it may be necessary to change the hotel to one of similar quality or upgrade.
